Information from the dental health survey

Our school has recently been involved in the National Oral Health Survey of 5-Year-Old children. Only a small number of children were invited to take part, but here are some key points that can help everyone:

Looking After Your Child's Teeth

Healthy teeth help children eat, speak, and smile with confidence. Forming good habits early makes a big difference!

Simple Top Tips

- **Brush twice a day** – morning and bedtime.
- **Use a pea-sized amount of fluoride toothpaste** (just a smear if under 3).
- **Supervise brushing** until your child is at least 7.
- **Choose water or milk** instead of sugary drinks.
- **Keep sweets and treats to mealtimes** to protect teeth.

Visiting the Dentist

Regular check-ups are really important.

- **NHS dental care is free for children.**
- Children aged 3-16 can have **fluoride varnish** painted on their teeth at least twice a year.
- This simple treatment helps **strengthen teeth and prevent decay.**
