Important Notice: School Parking and Safety

We would like to remind all parents to be very careful when parking near the school. We are worried about cars parking on the road and blocking access.

Please follow these safety rules:

- **Road Safety:** We do not recommend that children walk to cars parked on the roadside.
- **Visibility:** There are many cars in this area, which makes it hard for drivers to see small children.
- **Drive Slowly:** Please drive with extra care and keep your speed very low near the school.
- **Supervision:** Children must stay with an adult if they are near the road or the rear car park.

Using the Rear Car Park You may now use the car park at the back of the school to drop off your children. From there, pupils can walk directly onto the KS2 playground. Please remember:

- This is a **one-way system**.
- This area is for **dropping off only**, not for long-term parking.
