### Y6 residential

This week, Year 6 spent three days in the Peak District at Kingswood Peak Venture. We did many activities such as: climbing, zipwire, leap of faith, fire lighting, shelter building, archery, obstacle courses and problem solving. ### Walk to School Project

Yesterday, we had Rob from Living Streets visit us to launch our Walk to School Project. We did a baseline survey with children and 42% said that they use a car to get to school - this was really high. In our assembly, Rob told us loads of facts about how cars parked outside our school release carbon dust and rubber particles that damage the air that we breathe. This links to our sustainability theme. From Monday 10th, children will be tracking how children come to school and if they walk, cycle or scoot, once a week for the entire month, they earn a badge for each month. There will also be a trophy for the best class and other rewards. We are so excited for this! Let's get walking.





### Y4 multiplication check

The multiplication check has been happening this week and 35 children have completed the check so far and have done amazingly.. Next week, it will continue for the year 4s who have not completed the check yet.
