### **Reading**

Competition time! Last week, we started a competition to see which class could get the most pupils completing quizzes on accelerated reader over the next 2 weeks. There is still another week left of the competition but so far 3W are in the lead with 20 children having completed quizzes and both year 5 classes are just behind that with 15 children completing quizzes.



Accelerated reader helps your child choose the correct level of book. They answer questions based on what they have read. It tells you how much they have understood what they have read. You can complete quizzes on accelerated reader at home. You log on using the QR code. Your child's username is the first letter of your first name and 4 letters of your last name. E.g. Joe Bloggs would be Jblog The password is abc.

### **Train/Museum/Market Experience Y1 to Y6**

Children from Year 1 to Year 6 have the opportunity to experience visiting Doncaster by Train and having a look around the Market and also the Museum. Please make sure you complete the consent form and so your child can attend. We are asking children to take some spending money, no more than £5.
