### **Mobile Phones**

As you may be aware the DFE has published guidance over the use of mobile phones. The documentation can be found here: Mobile phones in schools - February 2024 (publishing.service.gov.uk)

The DFE have stated that the use of mobile phones should be prohibited. At our school we do not allow mobile phones and children should not have them in the playground or access to them during the school day.

However, in some circumstances, we recognise that children have phones because they walk home independently, and it may be needed for safety. In these circumstances, children hand their phones into the school office on arrival. Unfortunately, we have noticed an increase in how many are handed in. Whilst the school may keep the phones during the day, we take no responsibility for loss or damage. If you feel that your child falls into exceptional circumstances and needs to bring their phone to



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school, please complete the form sent to you on parentmail. We will not prevent children from handing them in from now, however from the start of the summer term, we can only accept phones that parents have notified us that they need to bring in.

Please note that due to safeguarding and behaviour, we will be forced to adopt processes for any child found with a phone that has not been handed into the main office. Updated polices will be sent to families soon. This is already in place.
