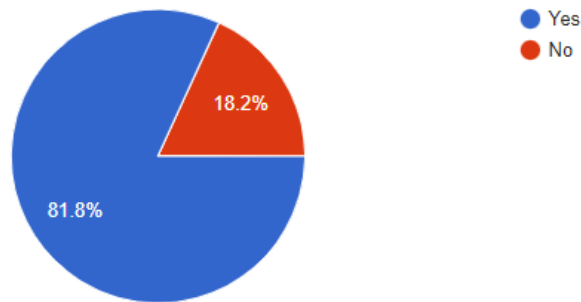

We did:

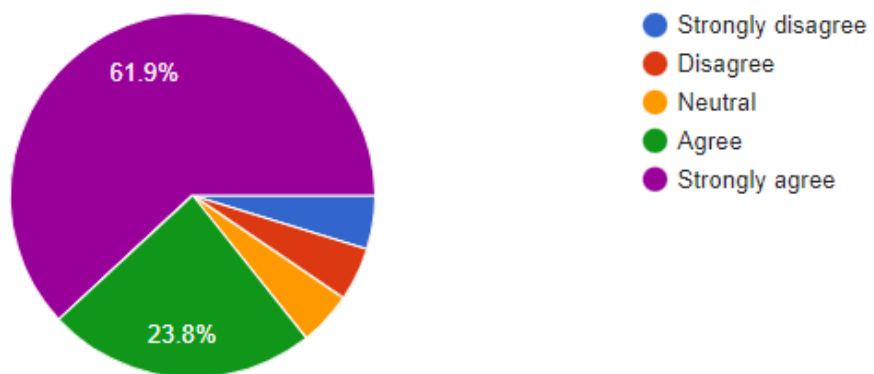
Support plans should be shared during support plan meetings.

Arrange an SEND parents meeting with local High schools.

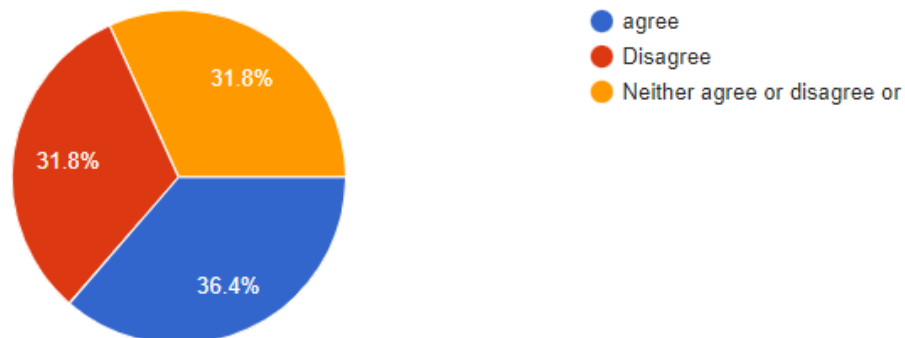
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I feel I have sufficient information and communication about my child's progress.

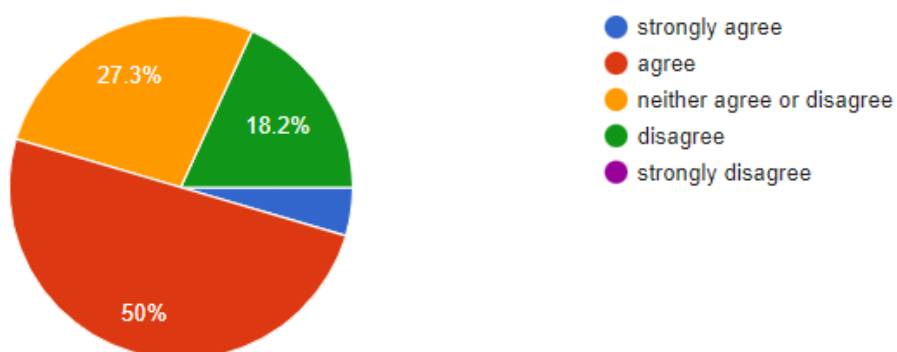
Throughout the year we offer the following opportunities for you to discuss your child's progress:

We will also share on our website.

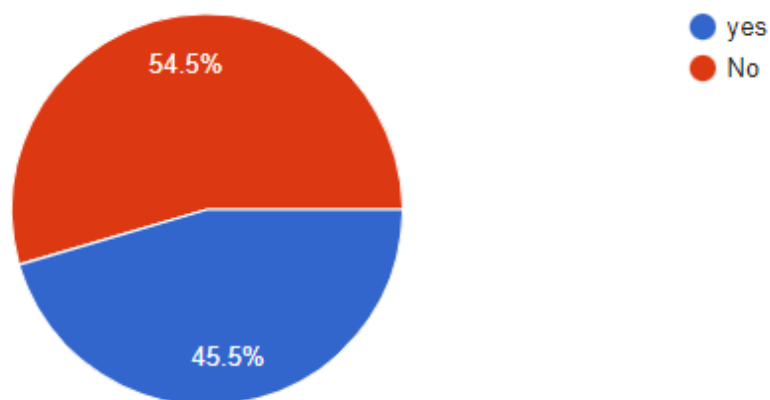
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I know which interventions my child is accessing if any.

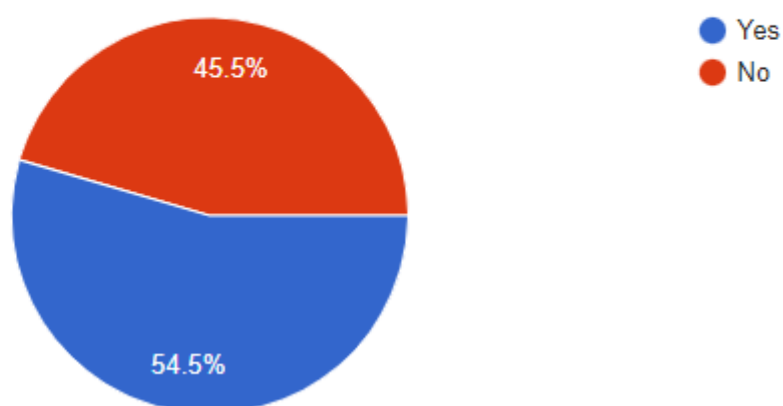
We did:
