



Some people are mean and treat people who are different than them unfairly.




That is called racism.



Racism is NOT okay.




Racism is hurtful. When people are treated poorly because they are a different race or color, it makes them feel sad and angry.

It is important to respect and love all humans no matter what they look like.




I cannot control what others might say or do, but I can control my attitude and actions.
