Each week parents and school staff sign the reading record. Comments can be added too!

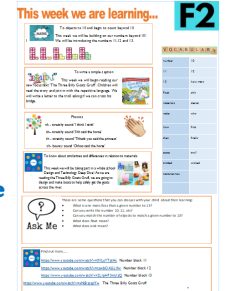
Staying connected supporting your child's learning

In addition, weekly 'We are learning to Leaflets' will be sent out on ParentMail. This tells you exactly what your child is learning each week. It contains information about vocabulary and suggested things to do and talk about.

The school will also run sessions to support you further

Home Learning – Chat, Read, Do!

Home learning is set fortnightly. This can be set by teachers on Seesaw. Children are asked to upload their learning on here too! School staff will comment/acknowledge all children's home learning. We kindly request the children and parents do not use this as a method of contacting the staff teacher. Unfortunately we cannot respond to these messages.



Scheduled Reports on your child's learning

Parent's Evening will take place in the Autumn and Spring Term. The purpose of this is to discuss your child's learning and progress. Teachers will also discuss their health and well-being in school, behaviour and attitude to learning.

In the Summer term, teachers will provide all families with a written report. This will include assessment levels

Year 1, Year 2 and Year 6 parents will also receive mock assessment results, prior to statutory assessments in May.
